






The Lord has put many circumstances in our lives to help them see that God is good, He is always faithful, and always cares for us and is with us! With God's guidance and wisdom, we have been able to guide our children on having personal relationship with the Lord and trusting Him more. And the training and guiding continues in that area! We have included them on this journey, opened up the forum to put out all our fears, desires, and apprehensions on the table, and then crushed the lies and replaced them with truth and what God wanted to do in our lives. All of our lives! "Let's go on this adventure for Jesus" we told them "and let's do it together."

HOW ARE THEY ADJUSTING?

They have adjusted so well to living in Mexico! Sure there has been the occasional hurdle with the heat, the bugs/mosquitos, the food, and attempting to fit into a totally different culture. It isn't easy trying to make friends when you're the new guy, let alone in another country, and you don't know the language. But they've been able to do it! I truly believe God knows His perfect timing for everything. Any younger and our children may not have adjusted so well. Any less life

experiences back at home, and they may not have learned and been able to apply certain life lessons! Our children are very outgoing. They are confident, loud, silly, and full of life! They are very much like their parents! They are able to make friends wherever they go and influence those around them in mighty ways. Although not perfect (just like us adults), God uses them and wants to do a work in and through their lives just as much as ours.


Since here, our kids have embraced their new surroundings. They want to know everything about everything, especially the boys. They are complete boys wanting to discover, hunt, and figure out how to do everything and how everything works. And our landlord has enjoyed teaching them and all of us all the secrets to the trades. The kids have gone fishing a few times and learned how to net catch and clean fish (we have yet to go deep sea fishing for larger fish! That's next!); they have learned how to take care of chickens; James Jr. has even learned how to properly kill and clean a chicken; they've released baby turtles back into the ocean and they've gone crab hunting on more than one occasion; they know how to open coconuts with a dull machete to get to the heart of them (this yummy soft spongy center of a coconut), and they have also learned when fruit is ripe enough to pick from the trees in our yard. They play soccer in the dirt, ride their bikes to school, and come home to do chores like washing clothes by hand and hanging them to dry or sweeping the dirt that constantly comes into the house. It's amazing to watch them adjust and be joyful doing it!



Over the last six months they have made friends with many local kids in their school and the pueblo and constantly play and interact with them. They have also befriended some of the young adults from our Spanish school and young bible students from the base. If they are not playing fútbol with the local kids by our house, then they are usually playing volleyball with the young adults and bible students by the base. Throughout the week but especially on weekends, our house is full of the neighborhood kids and sometimes the young adults from our Spanish school. James, Leilani, and Jacob push themselves to learn and speak the Spanish language, and we have really seen them both step out more to speak and accelerate with communication. As they have learned more of the language, it has become easier to be able to communicate better and develop relationships. The little girl who lives upstairs from us has even asked us and the kids on more than one occasion not to move because she'd miss us too much (as we would them)! Recently, our kids were even asked to help an English teacher who wanted them to come and converse with other local pueblo kids once a week in English to help them practice. And they were more than willing.

They are very fortunate to have each other. Our kids have always been close, a team, a force to be reckoned with...the Cadena Clan. Although they have the normal disagreements, we've never allowed for bad attitudes to stay or strife or complaining spirits to linger. It's always been an opportunity to better their relationships and unite. They have each other's backs and stick together, something that we think is even more key coming on the field. We know they will look out for each other and also hold each other accountable.

They are always finding more ways to show the love of Jesus, extend a helping hand, and work hard in all they do, including working on themselves! It is something the Lord has helped us as parents discern and train them up in, and here in Mexico, it is simply another level of training to bring forth more of who they are called to be!



GOD WANTS TO USE YOUR CHILDREN


